- 1. Call to Order: Chair Dorsa called the meeting to order at 7 PM.
- 2. Introductions of Members, Staff, and Guests: Chair Dorsa asked that everyone make a self-introduction and what organization they represent.
- 3. Approval of Agenda: (additions and/or deletions): The agenda was approved by unanimous consent.
- 4. Approval of Minutes for Regular Meeting on September 19, 2016: The minutes were approved by unanimous consent.
- 5. Lew May, BT General Manager: Mr. May gave a PowerPoint Presentation on Bloomington Transit services and accomplishments.
- 6. September 2016 Ridership Report: Perry Maull reported there was a substantial increase in ridership for September 2016 compared to September 2015. He speculated that some of increase may be the result that automatic passenger counters have been installed in all of the buses resulting in more accurate passenger counts than in the past when counting was done manually by the bus drivers.
- 7. First Quarter FY 2017 Financial Statements: Perry Maull said that Campus Bus had a fine first quarter.
- 8. Comparative Financial Statements FY 1999 to FY 2016: Perry Maull explained that Campus Bus has worked itself out of a financial hole to a solid financial footing over the period from FY 1999 to FY 2016.
- 9. School of Informatics and Computing Data Analysis Project: Logan Keating explained the project he lead to better analyze the massive amount of data that is produced by the

DoubleMap bus tracking and automatic passenger counting to improve the scheduling of buses.

- 10. Bus Service Options for FY 2018: Perry Maull asked that members begin thinking about any changes that they may want to suggest for next academic year. Tyler Knox suggested that LED displays be installed in bus shelters that show the DoubleMap bus tracking. Perry Maull responded that IUSA had looked into this a number of years ago. He would find that information and put an item on the November agenda. There was a suggestion about adding bus service for game days. Logan Keating responded that Campus Bus just doesn't have the capacity to add buses for special events. We have been barely meeting staffing requirements for regular services this semester. Jim Grandorf suggested looking at more "limited" routes that provide direct and frequent service, rather than full loops around campus. Perry Maull said that there will be a full agenda item on bus service options for FY 2018 on the November agenda.
